CAPSTONE ADVISORS STARTS RENOVATION OF FESTIVAL AT OLD BRIDGE SHOPPING CENTER

IN WOODBRIDGE, VA.

Center to be Renamed Dillingham Square

CARLSBAD, Calif., June 1, 2013 — Capstone Advisors of Carlsbad, Calif., has received permit approval from Prince William County for the renovation of its 235,000-square-foot, Food Lion-anchored shopping center in Woodbridge, Va. As part of the renovation, the center will be renamed Dillingham Square to reflect its location on Dillingham Square, which is just off Old Bridge Road.

Construction, which starts this week, is expected to be completed by the fall of 2013.

"Our primary goal is improving visibility," said Ira Schwartz, senior vice president with the Capstone Advisors real estate investment and development firm. "We will incorporate architectural features to add height to the center, making businesses more visible from Old Bridge Road."

The remodeling program will include a facade renovation to add dormers and peaks across portions of the center and on the free-standing buildings, new landscaping, asphalt repairs and new signage throughout the center. The landscaping plan includes improving sight lines along Old Bridge Road by removing overgrown and misshapen plants. New trees, planting beds, shrubs and ornamental grasses will be planted, creating a warm and inviting environment.

"We're really excited about the renovation," said Payton Polychrones of Michael's Florist, a tenant in the center. "Small businesses are what make Festival at Old Bridge special, and we're thrilled the renovation will make us more visible to those who drive by the center."

Schwartz said all businesses at the shopping center will remain open during construction and the center's annual trick-or-treat event in October 2013 will go on as scheduled.

The Rappaport Companies of McLean, Va., will provide construction management services for the renovation, and will also continue to provide property management and leasing services. The general contractor is Ashland Construction. The architect is Rounds Van Duzer Architects, and the landscape architect is Landgarden Landscape Architects.

Festival at Old Bridge shopping center is at Dillingham Square and Old Bridge Road in Woodbridge. The center is anchored by Food Lion and Gold's Gym and is owned by Old Bridge Investments, LLC.
